Agriculture Research Investments in New Mexico

- New Mexico has 2 ARS research units:
 - Cotton Ginning Research
 - Range Management Research

The cactus moth could have devastating effects on cactus populations in the western U.S. Researchers at **New Mexico State University** are working to reduce cactus moth infestations by introducing sterile male moths into wild populations, thereby producing inviable offspring.

Small Business Benefits in New Mexico

New Mexico small businesses received \$200,00 through the Small Business Innovation Research and Small Business Technology Transfer programs within USDA

In Santa Fe, Vista Photonics Inc. received an SBIR grant to develop a portable device that will more accurately measure groundwater contaminants.

Agriculture Value in New Mexico

- New Mexico has 24,700 farms that account for \$4 billion in total commodities, \$884 million in agricultural exports and nearly 52,400 jobs
- U.S. public investments in agriculture research and development produce benefit-cost ratios of 20:1 and higher
